

Bhutan Left Bank Bridge





Overview

Cantilever beams were developed in order to cross increasingly wide streams or rivers, where simple wooden beams had a limited range of about 10 meters. Linking Punakha Dzong to Shengana, Samdingkha, and Wangkha villages across the Tsang Chu River (aka Po Chu), this is one of the longest suspension bridges in Bhutan. The devastating floods that occurred on 4th and 5th October 2025 left behind extensive damage to various critical national infrastructure. The Department of Surface Transport (DoST), Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport (MoIT), carried out a detailed on-site assessment and identified a total of. This is a list of bridges and viaducts in Bhutan, including those for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. Punakha Suspension Bridge, which is always adorned with colorful prayer flags, is the perfect. Cantilever beams were developed in order to cross increasingly wide streams or rivers, where simple wooden beams had a limited range of about 10 meters. Two arms with timber superimposed are built on either side of the river, above the highest flood-level point, while being weighted to allow an increasingly large cantilevering, and solid wooden beams are then fixed on each end of the arms with wooden pegs. Bridges o

Bhutanese Bazams or Wooden Cantilever Bridges

Bazams or wooden Cantilever Bridges were invented for situations where wooden single-span bridges were not sufficiently long to span a river. The limit for such bridges was about 10 meters.
