depends on the cable. Section 318-3 indicates that cable tray in hazardous locations shall contain only the cable types

## Bathroom cables

---

Cables that pass through locations which contain a bath or shower, either on the surface, or concealed in a wall at a depth less than 50mm, have required additional protection for over 40
