The Standard Color-Code System designates red as the color for fire safety equipment and safety containers for flammables. It identifies emergency devices, including emergency shut-off switches, stop bars, and buttons, as mandated by OSHA's 1910. Caution, equipment under repair Warnings should be located at the starting point or power source of machinery. Local Jurisdictions may use different standards - check with your primary agency. Fire safety signages and color codes provide visual guidance that helps workers identify escape routes, firefighting equipment, alarms, hazards, and safe areas.
