

Distance from distribution box to roadside





Overview

The USPS recommends that mailboxes be positioned 6 to 8 inches away from the edge of the road. Knowing the distance between a distribution box and the septic tank is critical for proper wastewater management.

Mailboxes

Standards for Installing Mailboxes on County Roads

In general, non-breakaway objects should be located 12 - 18 feet from the edge of the travel lane for a road posted at 55 mph or under, and 20-34 feet for roads over 55 mph.

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Mailboxes on rural highways shall be set with the roadside face of the box offset from the edge of the traveled way a minimum distance of the greater of the following:

How many distance from ground when install distribution box?

Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters. The horizontal distance between switchbox and fixed electrical equipment should not exceed 3m.
