

Electric distribution box fire in Senegal





Overview

A Civil security expert has said it is likely that a "short circuit" caused the fire that gutted a hospital in Western Senegal killing 11 newborn babies on Wednesday. With a national electricity access rate of 84%, Senegal is making progress towards universal energy access, yet more than 30 % of rural communities remain disconnected from the grid. As part of the Just Energy Transition Partnership, Senegal has committed to bold reforms to increase renewable. A fire broke out in the early hours of Saturday morning at Kaolack's central market, destroying eight shops and causing material losses estimated at nearly 20 million CFA francs. Warehouse fires across Africa have become a recurring industrial safety concern, with incidents increasingly linked to poor electrical systems, unsafe storage practices, and weak enforcement of fire safety standards. For Senegal, Vinci will supply 200 kilometers of high-voltage overhead and underground lines, including 100 distribution stations – all of this delivered within 36 months.
