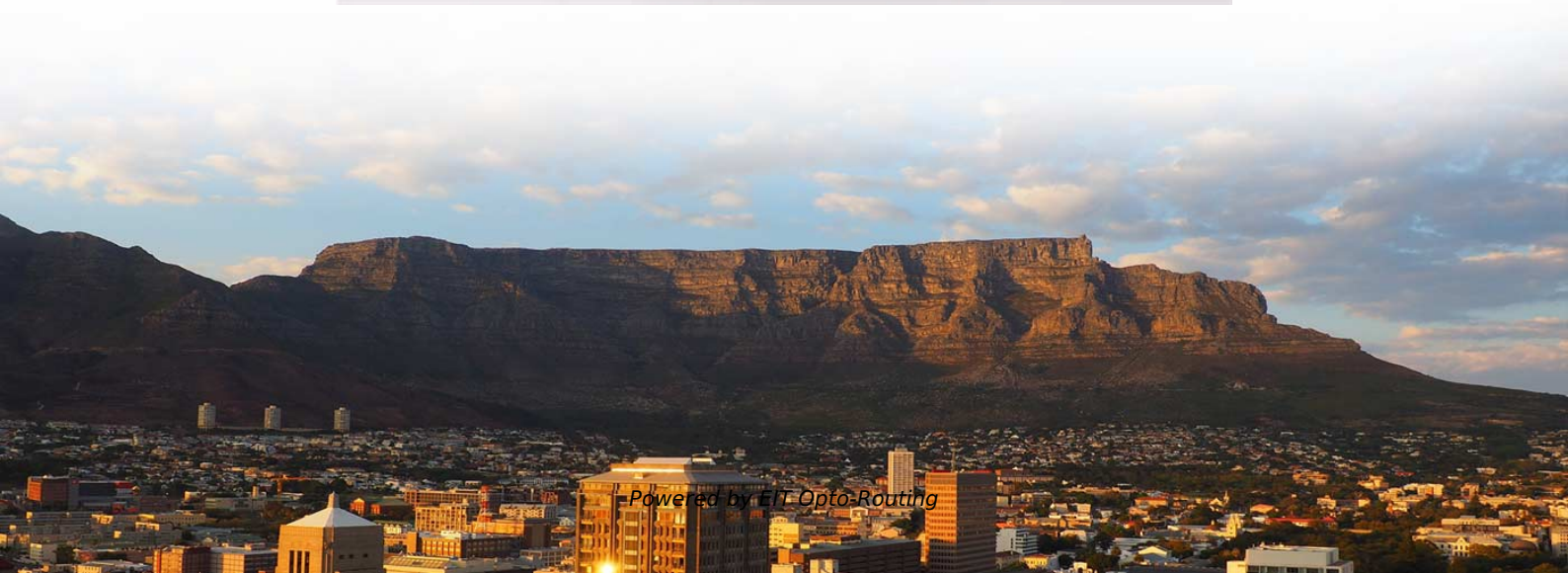


Guyana promotes fiber optic cables
