The algorithm calculates the best loop-free path through a switched Layer 2 network by assigning a role to each port based on the role of the port in the active topology:

Connect Ethernet 2/0/1 of the switch with a multicast source, and connect port OLT 3/0/1 of the OLT with an ONU, which is bound to ONU 3/0/1:1, through an optical splitter.
