Overview

The new cable using the latest submarine fibre optic technologies, known as CELIA, Caribbean ELite Alliance, will span over 3700 km and link key points in the Caribbean and North America, featuring a minimum of 8 fibre pairs, offering a minimum of 22 Terabits per second per fibre. The Jamaican government this week said it had signed a non-binding letter of intent with digital infrastructure provider Trans Americas Fiber System for a subsea cable project to "strengthen the country's digital infrastructure. The Caribbean region heavily relies on submarine cables for internet connectivity, which are crucial for linking the islands to international internet hubs and managing the region's internet traffic.
