Overview

The move is part of a broader drive to strengthen the country's digital backbone and reduce reliance on expensive satellite. On Friday, the fibre optic implementation committee, chaired by Deputy Minister of ICT & Postal Services, David Yau Yau, approved a budget of over \$9 million US Dollars.
